MEA Hall of Fame Award

The MEA Hall of Fame recognizes those outstanding individuals who have contributed significantly to their company and the energy industry through exceptional service in MEA committees, conferences, and training classes.

The program is open to individuals currently employed by or retired from MEA member companies. Both utility and associate (vendor-company) personnel are eligible.

Criteria for induction into the **MEA Hall of Fame** include extensive service and leadership on an MEA committee, speaking or moderating MEA conference sessions or training classes, participation in MEA planning events and attendance at MEA conferences and training classes. Candidates should be the “cream of the crop” in terms of their service to the industry through MEA committees and events.

Nominations are reviewed and voted on by the MEA Board of Directors. Various factors are considered in selecting individuals for the Hall of Fame. One criteria is the points system outlined on the Nomination Form.

Nominations into the MEA Hall of Fame

MEA is soliciting your nomination(s) for individuals to be inducted into the 2009 Hall of Fame class. The induction for electric personnel will take place on Wednesday, May 6th at the Electric Operations Conference in Springfield, IL (electric personnel) or Wednesday, August 5th at the Gas Operations Conference in Ames, IA (gas personnel). MEA will waive the registration fee for the conference for inducted individuals; travel and living expenses will be the responsibility of the nominating company.

All nominations will be reviewed and voted on by the Executive Committee of the MEA Board of Directors.
